# **Steel Reinforcing Bar**

## Exported from the Republic of Korea, Malaysia, Singapore, Spain, Taiwan, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Republic of Turkey Further extension of time granted to issue

### Further extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

#### Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 17 October 2014, I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of steel reinforcing bar (rebar) exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (Korea), Malaysia, Singapore, Spain, Taiwan, the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand) and the Republic of Turkey (Turkey).

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2014/100. This ADN is available on the internet at <u>www.adcommission.gov.au</u>.

Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2015/13 advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 23 March 2015. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Parliamentary Secretary).

To be able to conduct verification of exporters' data, I have requested a further extension of time under subsection 269ZHI(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) to publish the SEF.

The Parliamentary Secretary has, under subsection 269ZHI(3) of the Act, further extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record by no later than 1July 2015. Interested parties will be invited to make submissions to the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record.

A recommendation to the Parliamentary Secretary will now be made in a report due on or before 17 August 2015.
