Our discussion earlier today about the exporter questionnaire refers.

ALSTOM Grid Australia, acting on behalf of the ALSTOM transformer manufacturing units named below in our email of 6 September 2013 (the "ALSTOM Exporter Units"), kindly request that the Commission grants the ALSTOM Exporter Units an extension of time to submit exporter questionnaires for the purposes of this investigation.

The reasons for this request are the following:

- All of the ALSTOM Exporter Units have informed us that they have not received copies of the exporter questionnaire to date;
- All communications received by ALSTOM Grid Australia have thus far referred only to the importers questionnaire;
- Neither ALSTOM Grid Australia nor the ALSTOM Exporter Units were aware of the existence of the exporter questionnaire until today;
- It is expected that the ALSTOM Exporter Units will export transformers falling within the scope of this investigation into Australia, either within the time period of the investigation or in the near- to mid-term future;
- ALSTOM believes that it is vitally important that it be allowed to participate in the investigation, in both its own and the interests of the investigation;
- ALSTOM Grid Australia can offer the investigation its unique insights into the subject matter of the
  investigation, as it has been both a local manufacturer and an importer of transformers falling within the
  scope of the investigation.

Given that we have only today been provided with the exporter questionnaires, and in the event that the Commission is prepared to grant an extension of time, we would request the longest possible extension period within which to respond.

ALSTOM Grid Australia and the ALSTOM Exporter Units would also like the opportunity to make general submissions in relation to the investigation.
