CORRIGENDUM TO TERMINATION REPORT TER 284

ALLEGED DUMPING OF HOT ROLLED PLATE STEEL

EXPORTED FROM

KOREA BY HYUNDAI STEEL COMPANY AND POSCO STEEL AND TAIWAN

27 November 2015

BACKGROUND

On 25 November 2015, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) published Termination Report number 284 (REP 284) in relation to allegations by BlueScope Steel Ltd (BlueScope) that hot rolled plate steel exported to Australia at dumped prices from Korea, by Hyundai Iron & Steel Co Ltd and POSCO Steel, and all exporters from Taiwan, has caused material injury to the Australian industry producing like goods.

In REP 284, the Commissioner set out the reasons on which he based his decision to terminate the investigation.

A Public Notice in respect of his decision and TER 284 were published on the <u>public</u> <u>record</u> on the Commission's website at <u>www.adcommission.gov.au</u> on 25 November 2015.

Following publication of the Public Notice and TER 284, the Commission became aware that one exporter was incorrectly referred to in those documents as 'Hyundai Iron and Steel Co Ltd'. The correct reference is to 'Hyundai Steel Company'. To rectify this, the Commissioner has varied the notice published on 25 November 2015 to correctly identify Hyundai Steel Company.

The variation to the Public Notice only affects Hyundai Steel Company and does not affect any other aspect of the Commissioner's decision. This variation takes effect from 25 November 2015.

The purpose of this corrigendum is to replace all references to Hyundai Iron and Steel Co Ltd in TER 284 and their subsequent abbreviations to 'Hyundai' with 'Hyundai Steel Company'. This corrigendum should be read in conjunction with TER 284.
