## **Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2016/29**

*Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB*

**Notice of extension of time to make a declaration  
under subsection 269ZDB(1A)**

**Review of measures in relation to certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the  
People’s Republic of China by Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd**

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed a review of measures in relation to the certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People’s Republic of China by Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd. He provided his report (Report 285) to me on 29 February 2016.

An Application for Judicial Review (‘Application’) was filed in the Federal Court of Australia in relation to Report 285 on 17 March 2016. As a result, I consider there are special circumstances that prevent me from making a declaration under section 269ZDB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* within 30 days after receiving Report 285.

Accordingly, I extend the period of time for me to make a declaration in relation to Report 285 until 28 days after the Application has been determined.
