**Notice of extension of time to make a declaration
under subsection 269ZDB(1A)**


**Review of measures in relation to certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the
People's Republic of China by Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd**

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed a review of measures in relation to certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People's Republic of China by Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd. The Commissioner provided his report (Report 285) to the then Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science on 29 February 2016.

An application for judicial review was filed in the Federal Court of Australia in relation to Report 285 on 17 March 2016. The Federal Court's decision regarding the application for judicial review was handed down on 9 November 2016. A notice of appeal of this decision was lodged by the Applicants in this matter on 24 November 2016. As a result, I consider there are special circumstances that prevent me from making a declaration regarding Report 285 under section 269ZDB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901*.

Accordingly, I extend the period of time for me to make a declaration in relation to Report 285 until 28 days after the appeal has been determined.
