

Power Transformer Dumping Investigation – Technical Experts

Should the Anti-Dumping Commission decide to appoint a Technical Expert or Experts to assist with the power transformer dumping investigation, Wilson Transformer Company recommends the following guidelines -

Overview of proposed activities

1. The Technical Experts act for and as directed by the Anti-Dumping Commission.
2. The Technical Experts investigate and verify the claims made by the Importers and Domestic suppliers are valid technically and from a cost perspective.
3. The Technical Experts verify all the parts and services are in the transformer product supplied.
4. The Technical Experts verify all the cost elements of the parts and services are in the transformer price.
5. The Technical Experts verify comparisons are on a like for like basis on the basis of the products being supplied to Australia against Australian customer specifications. This includes compliance with: - The Customer Specification, Relevant Standards, OH&S requirements both in the factory and on site, Australian legal and statutory requirements, Australian labour laws, etc
