Jukka Mäntynen – Anti-Dumping Commission

Mr. Henderson indicated that he was grateful for the call and that he is happy to maintain contact with the Commission regarding his activities pursuing anti-circumvention matters in the USA.

Mr. Henderson discussed his organisation's efforts pursuing a Vietnamese aluminium extrusions manufacturer which is suspected of anti-circumvention activities and is party to certain law suits, including transshipment.

Mr. Henderson discussed his organisation's concerns related to a stockpile of aluminium that has been transported to Vietnam from Mexico as part of a scheme to circumvent anti-dumping measures in the USA.

Mr. Mäntynen provided an outline of Anti-Circumvention Inquiry 447 and of the Commission's role and procedures conducting such inquiries.

Mr. Mäntynen indicated that the Commission would welcome any submissions or information that may be helpful to inquiry 447.
