



**INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGED DUMPING OF  
CERTAIN CRYSTALLINE SILICON PHOTOVOLTAIC MODULES OR PANELS EXPORTED  
FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

**NOTE FOR FILE – TRINA SOLAR – EXTENSION TO EXPORTER QUESTIONNAIRE**

**Background**

On 20 May 2014, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) provided an exporter questionnaire to Changzhou Trina Solar Energy (Trina Solar) a selected Chinese exporter of certain crystalline silicon photovoltaic modules or panels (PV modules or panels) for sampling. The response to the exporter questionnaire was due on 25 June 2014.

On 26 May 2014, a consultant representing Trina Solar wrote to the Commission seeking an extension until 16 July 2014. The reasons for seeking an extension were;

- Exporter questionnaire responses are to be prepared for three members of the Trina Solar group of companies; and
- Trina Solar is currently involved in US anti-dumping and subsidy investigations as a selected exporter.

**Decision**

After carefully considering Trina Solar's request and taking into account the strict legislative timeframes, the Commission granted an extension of one week. The Commission expects the questionnaire response to be complete in all respects in the first instance.

The responses to the exporter questionnaire are now due by **02 July 2014.**
