Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

Chrome-plated steel bar exported from Romania

Notice pursuant to subsection 8(5) of the Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Science and the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science, having decided to issue a notice pursuant to subsection 269TG(1) and subsection 269TG(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of chrome-plated steel bar described in that notice (the goods), <u>DETERMINE</u>, pursuant to section 8(5) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (the Dumping Duty Act), that the interim dumping duty payable on those goods be worked out using the *ad valorem* duty method as specified in subsection 5(7) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Regulation 2013*.

Pursuant to subsection 8(5B) of the Dumping Duty Act, I have had regard to the desirability of fixing a lesser amount of duty. If the non-injurious price of goods of that kind as ascertained or last ascertained for the purposes of the dumping duty notice is less than the normal value of goods of that kind as so ascertained, or last so ascertained, a lesser amount of interim dumping duty is fixed such that the sum of:

- (i) the export price of goods of that kind as so ascertained, or last so ascertained, and
- (ii) the interim dumping duty payable on the goods the subject of the notice,

does not exceed that non-injurious price of goods of that kind as ascertained.

This notice applies to the goods and like goods entered for home consumption on and after 30 March 2016 in respect of which a valid security existed as at the date of publication of this notice.
