**ALUMINIUM EXTRUSIONS EXPORTED THROUGH ONE OR MORE THIRD  
COUNTRIES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

**MEETING WITH MYW LOGISTICS PTY LTD**

**5 APRIL 2018**

PRESENT:

The visit to MYW Logistics Pty Ltd was conducted to discuss and provide information on the Commission's anti-circumvention inquiry. The meeting was held at MYW Logistics Pty Ltd's premises in West Meadows, Melbourne.

The following matters were discussed:

- Jukka provided an overview of the inquiry, including inquiry timeframes, preparation of a public and confidential file note following this visit, and maintaining confidentiality with information and data.
- Max said he imported aluminium extrusions for an aluminium business, on behalf of another importer.
- Max said he imported three or four times for the importer.
- Max said the importer asked him to import on their behalf as they claimed they could not obtain an Australian Business Number.
- Max advised he used a Melbourne based freight business to transport the goods from the wharf to the recipient of the goods.
- Max said he no longer conducts business with the importer, and cannot contact them. He advised that they suddenly became uncontactable and they did not give a reason why they stopped contact. He understands that the importer has ceased operating.
- Max reiterated he was importing on behalf of the importer and that his business was in relation to freight forwarding.
- Jukka asked Max how the importer found his business. Max said it was via his website.

## PUBLIC RECORD

- Jukka asked when the shipments occurred. Max advised the shipments were early 2017.
- Jukka asked if Max has copies of the documents used for the shipments on behalf of the importer. Max said he did and supplied the Commission with copies of the documents.
- Jukka asked if Max had any contact with the aluminium business that received the imported goods. Max said that he did not and that all communication was with the importer.
- Jukka asked if Max had heard of a certain logistics company. Max said he had not.
- Andrew asked if Max had heard of the same logistics company by a different name. Max said he had not.
- Jukka asked if Max knew if the importer's owners had started a new business under a different name. Max said he did not know.
- Jukka asked about another business that imported aluminium. Max said knows the owner of that business and arranged customs clearance for them. Max also mentioned that the business is a small, home business.
- Jukka asked Max if he knew of any freight forwarders involved in transshipment in order to avoid anti-dumping measures. Max said he did not. Max said he is a freight forwarder only, and that he conducts his business according the documents that he is provided.
- Max said his business was started in 2013 and currently employs four people
- Max and Jukka discussed the various products that MYW Logistics has been involved with.
