SUBMISSION ON LIKE GOODS

We take note of the January 5, 2015 submission of Norske Skog, which reiterates an argument first presented by email, apparently, on August 19, 2014, that the Jeonju Paper Corporation's 46 gsm coloured newsprint is not a "like good to the goods the subject of the application." "Norske Skog does not consider that coloured newsprint is a like good to the goods the subject of investigation and should be excluded . . ." Norske Skog added that "coloured newsprint was not considered to be included within the goods description."

While Bowater Korea does not express a view as to whether Norske Skog's submission is correct, we would note that if the Commission accepts Norske Skog's argument that certain newsprint paper is not a "like good" and not "included within the goods description" because it is coloured, then the Commission must also accept that newsprint that has **sector accept** that newsprint that has **sector accept accept** that newsprint that has **sector accept acce**

could not be a "like good." We respectfully ask, therefore, that

of certain paper products] discussed by Bowater Korea in submissions of 4 December 2014 and 18 December 2014 be excluded from the Commission's anti-dumping calculations because it could not reasonably be considered, according to Norske Skog's own reasoning, a "like good to the goods the subject of the application."

Alternatively, even if such paper were a "like good," which we dispute, we would respectfully submit that it could not have caused material injury to the Australian newsprint industry because and, consequently, with the newsprint supplied by Norske Skog.
