Subject: Statement of Essential Facts regarding the resumption of anti-dumping investigation on imports of Quicklime originated from the Kingdom of Thailand

The Department of Foreign Trade ("DFT") wishes to refer to the Statement of Essential Facts No. 179A issued on 19 March 2013 pertaining to the above proceeding.

The DFT is fully aware that the recommendation for the termination of the investigation without imposition of AD measures has not been altered to such an extent that the period of investigation (POI) has remained the same and that no material injury in so far is an effect from the allegedly dumped imports. However, further clarification is required as the final paragraph of the section 8.8 of the report is concluded that "There is no evidence to suggest that there is a threat of material injury to the Australian industry that is foreseeable and imminent, unless dumping duties are imposed".

According the stated report and quotation above, it is to the understanding of the DFT that there are no grounds to impose anti-dumping duties whence injury was determined to be negligible and that no evidence of material injury threat was found to impose imminent effects on the Australian Industry. For this reason, The DFT would like to seek clarification from the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service of the meaning and possible implication of the quotation above, if the understanding was misinterpreted.

The DFT looks forward to receiving a reply to the concerns expressed and would greatly appreciate a positive response to the issues raised.
