Investigation No. 392 – Submission by Concrete Formwork Technologies Pty Ltd

I refer to the submission by Concrete Formwork Technologies Pty Ltd (“CFT”) concerning aluminium profiles used in concrete formwork.


Capral Limited (“Capral”) does not have any record in recent times of CFT approaching the company for an offer to supply aluminium profiles used in concrete formwork. Capral encourages CFT to make contact with Capral or one of the Australian aluminium extrusion companies to discuss sourcing and supply of aluminium profiles made locally in Australia.

Respectfully, Capral must disagree with the assertions made by CFT of the stated ‘artificial monopoly’ that it claims is evident in Australia. Contrary to CFT’s views, the Australian market for aluminium extrusions is very competitive and transparent, with a wide choice of supply from local manufacture and imports.

Capral encourages CFT to contact a local manufacturer to further examine options for supply (including Capral itself). Where CFT can demonstrate the concrete formwork cannot be supplied by local manufacturers, opportunities exist for an exemption from the dumping measures to apply.
