



## INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGED DUMPING OF

### CERTAIN CRYSTALLINE SILICON PHOTOVOLTAIC MODULES OR PANELS EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

#### NOTE FOR FILE-ET SOLAR GROUP- EXTENSION TO EXPORTER QUESTIONNAIRE

#### Background

On 23 May 2014, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) provided an exporter questionnaire to ET Solar Industry Limited (ET Solar) a selected Chinese exporter of certain crystalline silicon photovoltaic modules or panels (PV modules or panels) for sampling. The response to the exporter questionnaire was due by 25 June 2014.

On 16 June 2014, a consultant representing ET Solar wrote to the Commission seeking an extension until 9 July 2014.

The reasons for the extension are that ET Solar:

- (i) has to coordinate with three related companies' staff to prepare the questionnaire responses. This is because three different related companies are involved in producing and distributing PV modules or panels.
- (ii) requires to translate the questionnaire into Chinese, and translate all the Chinese documents into English which is a huge task for the Company

#### Decision

After carefully considering ET Solar's request and taking into account the strict legislative timeframes, the Commission granted ET Solar an extension of one week. The Commission expects the questionnaire response to be complete in all respects in the first instance including filing in the public record version of the questionnaire by this date.

The responses to the exporter questionnaire from ET Solar are now due by **2 July 2014**.
