**ANTI-CIRCUMVENTION INQUIRY 447**

**ALUMINIUM EXTRUSIONS EXPORTED THROUGH ONE OR MORE THIRD  
COUNTRIES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

**MEETING WITH CONCRETE FORMWORK TECHNOLOGIES PTY LTD**

**9 MAY 2018**

The visit to Concrete Formwork Technologies Pty Ltd (CFT) was conducted to discuss and seek information pertaining to Anti-Circumvention Inquiry 447 and to analyse imports of aluminium extrusions by CFT.

The meeting was held at CFT's premises in Kent Town, Adelaide.

The following is a summary of matters discussed:

- Jukka provided an overview of the inquiry, including inquiry timeframes, preparation of a public file note following this visit, and maintaining confidentiality with information and data.
- Jukka explained details of transshipment and of Anti-Circumvention Inquiry 447.
- The Commission confirmed that CFT had imported aluminium extrusions from certain countries. Robert commented that CFT made the decision to source its aluminium extrusions from certain overseas suppliers as a result of research, engagement with the Australian industry and enquiries made of Australian aluminium extruders as to their ability to manufacture the aluminium extrusions to CFT's specifications.

## PUBLIC RECORD

- CFT described its business operations and the markets it operates in.
- CFT described its processes regarding sourcing aluminium extrusions and other components for its products.
- CFT indicated that due to anti-dumping measures, it was necessary to source aluminium extrusions from countries other than China.
- CFT indicated that its Chinese supplier had arranged for aluminium extruders in two other countries to supply aluminium extrusions to CFT.
- CFT provided copies of documents related to imports of aluminium extrusions from China and from other countries and clarified certain details in them.
- CFT indicated that it had not visited the premises of those other aluminium extruders. Robert stated that CFT operates with the assistance of parties overseas and is not in the practice of visiting the premises of aluminium extruders from which it sources the aluminium extrusions, nor is this standard industry practice.
- Jukka extended to CFT an invitation that he has made to other interested parties to provide him with information regarding transshipment and gave permission to pass on his contact details to anybody who may have information relevant to the inquiry.
- CFT indicated that it had no objection to the Commission contacting its Chinese supplier and discussing the inquiry. (The Commission subsequently attempted to do so but received no response to its calls.)
