## **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2017/08**

### **Zinc Coated Steel**

### **Exported from India, Malaysia and Vietnam**

### **Extension of time granted to issue Statement of Essential Facts**

*Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB*

On 7 October 2016, I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of zinc coated (galvanised) steel (the goods) exported to Australia from the Republic of India (India), Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam) and alleged subsidisation of the goods exported to Australia from India and Vietnam.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2016/105 available on the Commission's website at [www.adcommission.gov.au](http://www.adcommission.gov.au).

ADN No. 2016/105 advised that the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) would be placed on the public record by 25 January 2017.

Having considered a number of alleged subsidy programs from India and Vietnam, the allegation of a particular market situation in Vietnam and time required for an assessment of material injury caused to the Australian industry, I requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF under subsection 269ZHI(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act). The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base my recommendations to the Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science (the Parliamentary Secretary)<sup>1</sup> in relation to this investigation.

Following my request, on 14 January 2017 the Parliamentary Secretary, under subsection 269ZHI(3) of the Act, approved a 90 day extension to publish the SEF.

The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 25 April 2017. Interested parties are invited to make submissions in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record.

<sup>1</sup> On 19 July 2016, the Prime Minister appointed the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science as the Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science. For the purposes of this investigation, the Minister is the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science.

If the investigation is not terminated, a recommendation to the Parliamentary Secretary in relation to this investigation will be made in a report due on or before 9 June 2017.
