

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/89

Power transformers

Exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Indonesia, the Republic of Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam

Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 - Part XVB

On 29 July 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of power transformers exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Indonesia, the Republic of Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2013/64. This ADN is available on the Commission's web-site at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 18 November 2013. The SEF will set out the facts on which the Anti-Dumping Commissioner (Commissioner) proposes to base his recommendations to the Minister for Industry (the Minister).

Due to the complexity of the issues surrounding the investigation, as well as extensions of time allowed for various interested parties to supply information, the Commissioner requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF.

The Minister has, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than **18 March 2014**. Interested parties are invited to make submissions to the Commission in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before 30 April 2014. Documents included in the public record are available at www.adcommission.gov.au.
