We now have full year 2013 ABS import statistics for quicklime and hereunder is an update of the table of quantities and values of quicklime imports into Fremantle from Thailand provided in our letter of 21 October 2013 (copy attached):

It is of important note that the imports of quicklime from Thailand found to have been dumped by a margin of 48% during the IP and which continue to cause material injury to Cockburn, were in 2013 almost six times the 2010 volume and 11% below the 2010 export price.
