Hi Charles,

The Commission is currently preparing its final report into the alleged dumping of rod in coils exported from Indonesia, Taiwan and Turkey. The Parliamentary Secretary recently approved an extension for the finalisation of the report, which is now due to be presented to her by 13 May 2015.

As you would be aware, the Commission has received numerous submissions from OneSteel in relation to exports from Indonesia, and in particular goods exported by PT Ispat Indo.

OneSteel contends that the information provided to the Commission by Ispat contradicts the findings of the Indonesian Safeguards Committee and should therefore be rejected for the purposes of determining a normal value for Ispat.

After considering OneSteel's submissions and your own submission on behalf of Ispat, the Commission is of the view that additional information may assist in reconciling the inconsistency between the information submitted by Ispat to the Commission and that submitted to the Indonesian authorities. As such, the Commission would invite Ispat to supply it with the information provided to the Indonesian authorities detailing the nature of the injury it had allegedly suffered.

It would be appreciated if the information could be submitted by COB 24 April 2015.
