**REVIEW OF ANTI-DUMPING MEASURES

REP 248 Certain Aluminium Extrusions – China – Corrigendum

BACKGROUND

On 19 August 2015, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) published Final Report No. 248 (REP 248) in relation to the review of measures imposed on certain aluminium extrusions exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China.

In REP 248, the Commissioner recommended that the dumping duty notice and countervailing duty notice have effect in relation to:

- Tai Shan City Kam Kiu Aluminium Extrusion Co Ltd;
- Guangdong Zhongya Aluminium Co Ltd (countervailing only);
- PanAsia Aluminium (China) Co., Ltd;
- Guang Ya Aluminium Industries Co Ltd;
- Residual exporters; and
- All uncooperative and other exporters;

as if different variable factors had been ascertained.

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Parliamentary Secretary) accepted the Commissioner's recommendations. To give effect to this decision, a notice was published in *The Australian* newspaper and the *Commonwealth Government Gazette* on 19 August 2015.

Following the Parliamentary Secretary's decision, the Commissioner identified six entities that were incorrectly categorised as 'residual exporters'. To rectify this, the Parliamentary Secretary has varied the notice published on 19 August 2015 to correctly identify the 'residual exporters'.

The variation to the notice only affects the six entities incorrectly categorised as 'residual exporters' and does not affect any other aspect of the Parliamentary Secretary's decision. This variation takes effect from 19 August 2015.

This purpose of this corrigendum is to correctly list the 'residual exporters' identified on page 16 of REP 248 and should be read in conjunction with REP 248.
