**File Note:**

It has come to the attention of the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) that Korean hollow structural sections manufacturer Steelpia Co., Ltd (Steelpia) was not identified and included within Section 6.3.2 of the Preliminary Affirmative Determination (PAD) Report No. 177 in error.

Customs and Border Protection has received a questionnaire response from Steelpia and hence it should be included with Section 6.3.2 of the PAD Report No. 177.

This omission does not change the rate of securities to be imposed on goods manufactured by Steelpia, as a country-wide rate for all Korean exporters of 11.5% has been determined (refer to Australian Customs Dumping Notice No. 2011/62 and Chapter 12 of the PAD Report No. 177).
