**Background:**

Roger D Simpson and Associates Pty Ltd, representing ThyssenKrupp Mannex Pty Ltd (TKM), an importer of hot rolled structural steel (HRS) and Siam Yamato Steel Co Ltd (SYS), an exporter of HRS from Thailand, requested a meeting with the Anti-Dumping Commission. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Roger D Simpson and Associates Pty Ltd's submissions on behalf of SYS and TKM made following the publication of the Statement of Essential Facts.

**Discussed:**

Roger Simpson presented the following issues:

- Selection of steel grade used to calculate normal value;
- Form of anti-dumping measures; and
- Matters relating to dumping margin calculation and due allowance adjustments to the dumping margin calculation for SYS:
  - Date of sale;
  - Foreign exchange rollover/conversion;
  - Cutting 'cost' adjustment;
  - Production cost adjustment; and

- Level of trade adjustment.

The Commission noted that the issues and claims raised during the meeting reflected the issues and claims raised in recent submissions from Roger D Simpson and Associates Pty Ltd.

The Commission advised that it acknowledges the matters raised, is considering them and will make its findings in the Final Report.

The meeting concluded at approximately 11:30am.
