



## Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

### Certain aluminium extrusions

### Exported to Australia from Malaysia

#### *Notice pursuant to subsection 10(3B) of the Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975*

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science,<sup>1</sup> having decided to issue a notice pursuant to subsection 269TJ(1) and subsection 269TJ(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of certain aluminium extrusions described in that notice (the goods), DETERMINE, pursuant to subsection 10(3B) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (the Dumping Duty Act), that the interim countervailing duty referred to in subsection 10(3A) of the Dumping Duty Act be ascertained as a proportion of the export price of the goods.

Pursuant to subsection 10(3D) of the Dumping Duty Act, I have had regard to the desirability of fixing the amount of interim countervailing duty such that the sum of:

- (a) the export price of goods of that kind, as ascertained, or last ascertained; and
- (b) that amount of the interim countervailing duty as so fixed; and
- (c) the amount of interim dumping duty as fixed under section 8 of the Dumping Duty Act;

does not exceed the non-injurious price of goods of that kind as ascertained, or last ascertained, for the purposes of those notices.

Subject to section 45 and subsection 269TN(2) of the Act, this notice applies to the goods and like goods entered for home consumption on and after 20 April 2017 as per my declaration under section 269TJ of the Act and to which section 10 of the Dumping Duty Act applies.
