Quenched and Tempered Steel Plate

Exported from Finland, Japan and Sweden

Extension of time granted to issue the Final Report

to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 8 January 2014, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of Quenched and Tempered steel plate (Q&T steel plate) exported to Australia from Finland, Japan and Sweden.

Statement of Essential Facts No. 234 (SEF 234) for the investigation was published on 27 August 2014, and the Final Report to the Parliamentary Secretary to Minister for Industry (the Parliamentary Secretary) was due on 13 October 2014. The Final Report will set out the reasons, including the material findings of fact, which form the basis of my recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary in relation to the investigation.

A number of submissions have been received from interested parties requesting the Commission undertake further consideration of its findings set out in SEF 234. I consider that further time is required to enable the Commission to undertake this analysis and complete the Final Report. I therefore requested an extension of the deadline for providing the Final Report to the Parliamentary Secretary.

The Parliamentary Secretary has, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for me to provide my Final Report to him by 14 days. The Final Report is now due to the Parliamentary Secretary no later than 27 October 2014.
