We confirm that we act for an importer of deep drawn sinks, Tom Stoddart Pty Ltd trading as Stoddart Manufacturing.

Our client seeks an exemption from any dumping and countervailing duty notices that may be published in relation to investigation no. 238 concerning exports of deep drawn sinks from China. Under s8(7) and 10(8) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* the responsible Minister has the power to issue an instrument to exempt goods in certain prescribed circumstances including where a Tariff Concession Order ('TCO') is in force.

We **attach** copies of TCO numbers TC 1436584 and TC 1436587 which relate to cleaner's sinks and hand wash basins respectively.

You would be aware that, under s269C of the Customs Act, the core criterion for the granting of a TCO is that no substitutable goods are produced in Australia in the ordinary course of business. Hence, the granting of a TCO represents strong and clearly defined grounds for the granting of an exemption from dumping and countervailing duties. Further, in this case, the sole manufacturer and applicant in ADC case number 238, Tasman Sinkware Pty Ltd ('Tasman') provided letters to us, which were in turn provided to Australian Customs, confirming that it did not object to the granting of the two subject TCOs.

We further attach copies of correspondence from Tasman of 3 February 2015 confirming that it has no objection to the granting of a Ministerial exemption covering the two subject Tariff Concession Orders.

We would be pleased to provide any further information in support of this application should this be required and note that the Commission is due to provide its final report and recommendations to the responsible Minister by 19 February 2015.
