Alstom sought a meeting with the Commission to discuss the following topics:

- · Current status of investigation.
 - The Commission provided the current status.
- Exports from Indonesia.
 - Clarification around dates of exports from Indonesia, and the relevance to dumping margin calculations.
- · Exports from China.
 - Clarification around dates of exports; and
 - Eligibility for accelerated review, duty assessments, and reviews of anti-dumping measures.
- The calculation of profitability and ordinary course of trade tests for the purposes of establishing normal values.
- An Alstom request for further information.
 - The Commission undertook to respond to the request for certain information.
- Definition of the goods subject to investigation and the like goods manufactured and sold by Wilson's
- Factors other than dumping that are affecting Wilson's performance.

Alstom stated it would prepare confidential and public file submissions in respect of the issues discussed.
