## **Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975**

### **Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel**

### **exported from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

#### **Notice pursuant to subsections 8(5) and 8(5BA) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975***

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science,<sup>1</sup> having decided to issue a notice pursuant to subsection 269TG(1) and subsection 269TG(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect zinc coated (galvanised) steel described in that notice (the goods), DETERMINE, pursuant to subsection 8(5) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (the Dumping Duty Act), that the interim dumping duty payable on the goods is an amount worked out in accordance with the combination of fixed and variable duty method, specified in sub-regulations 5(2) and 5(3) of the Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Regulation 2013.

Pursuant to subsection 8(5BA) of the Dumping Duty Act, I have had regard to the desirability of specifying a method such that the sum of:

- (i) the export price of goods of that kind as so ascertained or last ascertained; and
- (ii) the interim dumping duty payable on the goods; and
- (iii) the interim countervailing duty payable under section 10 of the Dumping Duty Act on goods the subject of the notice under section 269TJ of the Act;


does not exceed the non-injurious price of goods of that kind as ascertained, or last ascertained, for the purpose of those notices.

This notice applies to the goods and like goods entered for home consumption on and after 1 June 2017.
