



## **Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975**

### **Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel exported from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

#### ***Notice pursuant to subsections 10(3B) of the Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975***

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science,<sup>1</sup> having decided to issue a notice pursuant to subsection 269TJ(1) and subsection 269TJ(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of zinc coated (galvanised) steel (the goods), DIRECT, pursuant to subsection 10(3B)(c) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (the Dumping Duty Act), that the interim countervailing duty referred to in subsection 10(3A) of that Act in respect of galvanised steel exported from India to Australia be ascertained by reference to a combination of a proportion of the export price of those particular goods and a measure of quantity of those particular goods.

Pursuant to subsection 10(3D) of the Dumping Duty Act, I have had regard to the desirability of fixing the amount of interim countervailing duty such that the sum of:

- (i) the export price of goods of that kind, as ascertained, or last ascertained; and
- (ii) that amount of the interim countervailing duty payable on the as so fixed; and
- (iii) the amount of interim dumping duty as fixed under section 8 of the Dumping Duty Act;


does not exceed the non-injurious price of goods of that kind as ascertained, or last ascertained, for the purposes of those notices.
