**TINDO SOLAR'S RESPONSE TO SEF NO. 239**

As you know, we represent Changzhou Trina Solar Energy Co Ltd ("TCZ") and Trina Solar (Changzhou) Science and Technology Co Ltd ("TST") to the investigation into the alleged dumping of PV modules or panels from China.

We note that Tindo Solar Pty Ltd ("Tindo Solar") has made a submission in response to SEF No. 239 on 4 May 2015, which is 7 days after the Commission's 27 April 2015 deadline for responses to this SEF.<sup>1</sup>

*As stated in SEF No. 239, the Commissioner is not obliged to have regard to any submission made after 27 April 2015 if to do so would, in the opinion of the Commissioner, prevent the timely termination or preparation of the report to the Parliamentary Secretary.*

It is very surprising that a domestic industry, which is seeking the imposition of anti-dumping measures on PV modules or panels exported from China on grounds that these exports are dumped and the cause of material injury to them, would make such a late response when the SEF notifies the Commission's proposal to terminate the investigation, subject to any submissions in response to the SEF.


It is also of note that Tindo Solar did not make any submissions to the Commission in response to the Exporter Visit Reports re the four Chinese exporters investigated posted on the EPR well before the publication of the SEF, which provide details of the Commission's preliminary dumping margin assessments that Tindo Solar is now expressing its disagreement with.
