ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/58

Import Data Assistance Programme commenced 1 July 2013

<u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) is to advise that the Import Data Assistance Programme commenced on 1 July 2013.

Import Data Assistance Programme

The Import Data Assistance Programme provides Australian manufacturers and producers that intend to lodge an application for anti-dumping or countervailing measures, or an application for an anti-circumvention inquiry, the opportunity to apply for ABS import data. If approved, the Anti-Dumping Commission will fund the cost.

The programme will facilitate better access to import data which Australian producers and manufacturers may require to effectively utilise Australia's anti-dumping system.

The Import Data Assistance Programme is administered by the new Anti-Dumping Commission and the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS).

To apply for import data assistance, Australian manufacturers and producers are required to submit an application form to the Commission. The application form, together with supporting guidelines detailing the eligibility criteria and information on how to complete the application form, will soon be available on the Commission's new website (<u>http://www.adcommission.gov.au/system/AssistanceAvailable.asp</u>)
