PV MODULES OR PANELS FROM CHINA


We note from the Commission's electronic public record¹ that the Government of China ("GOC") is not responding to the Commission's questionnaire concerning the alleged particular market situation ("PMS") in China re PV modules or panels for reasons provided in two letters sent to the Commission.

This non-response to the Commission's questionnaire by the GOC does not in any way impact on the necessity for the Commission to **have proof** that there is a PMS in China such that it does not permit proper comparison of prices of domestic sales of like goods and prices of PV modules or panels to Australia to decide that the alleged PMS does exist.

That the GOC has not provided certain information sought by the Commission does not mean that it is no longer necessary for the Commission to have the proof outlined above to reach a conclusion that the alleged PMS exists.

It is paramount that the facts available to the Commission from the CBSA's Statement of Reasons, Tindo's submissions and the Commission's on-site investigations in China, for reasons provided in our submissions of 13 and 15 July 2015 do not provide necessary proof that the alleged PMS exists.
