## Zinc coated steel and Aluminium zinc coated steel Exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and Taiwan

Longer period for decision Public notice under s.269TLA of the Customs Act 1901

The Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) has completed its investigations into the alleged dumping of zinc coated (galvanised) steel and aluminium zinc coated steel exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and Taiwan.

A full description of the goods is available in Australian Customs Dumping Notice (ACDN) No. 2012/40 (relating to the initiation) and ACDN No. 2012/62 (relating to the clarification of the goods). These ACDNs are available on the internet.

Customs and Border Protection reported its findings and recommendations to the Minister for Home Affairs on 30 April 2013. Decision making responsibility for this matter was subsequently transferred to me due to a conflict of interest. The Customs Act 1901 requires that a decision must be made whether or not to publish a dumping duty notice in respect of the goods within 30 days of receiving the recommendations or, if there are special circumstances that prevent the decision being made within that period, such longer time as the relevant Minister considers appropriate.

On 29 June 2013, Customs and Border Protection is due to report its findings and recommendations to me in relation to the alleged subsidisation of galvanised steel and aluminium zinc coated steel exported from China. The countervailing investigations are in relation to the same goods and have the same investigation period as the dumping investigations. It would be prudent to consider the dual impact of any dumping and subsidisation found in relation to the same goods. I consider that in these special circumstances I am prevented from making a decision on the dumping investigations within the prescribed 30 days.

I will make a decision in relation to the dumping investigations at the time of making a decision in relation to the countervailing investigations, which will be on or before 29 July 2013.
