

## INVESTIGATION INTO CERTAIN HOLLOW STRUCTURAL SECTIONS (HSS) CHINA, KOREA, MALAYSIA, TAIWAN AND THAILAND

## NOTE FOR FILE: EXTENSIONS TO QUESTIONNAIRE DUE DATES

## 9 November 2011

Customs and Border Protection has disseminated its Exporter Questionnaire for the above investigation to multiple exporters.

At the time of dissemination, Customs and Border Protection set the due date for submission of responses to the Questionnaire as 2 November 2011. Customs and Border Protection has received requests for extensions to this due date from certain exporters who have indicated their intent to cooperate with the investigation.

In line with Article 6.1.1 of the Anti-Dumping Agreement and 12.1.1 of the Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures, due consideration has been given to these extension requests, taking into account the circumstances of each exporter and the causes shown in their request. Consequently, the following extensions have been granted.

Customs and Border Protection has also disseminated its Thai Government Questionnaire and its Chinese Government Questionnaire to those respective governments, requesting information relating to the allegations made in the application of:

- the existence of a market situation within the Thai and Chinese HSS markets that renders domestic selling prices unsuitable for calculating normal values under s.269TAC(1); and
- the provision of countervailable subsidies to Chinese producers of HSS.

At the time of their dissemination, the date for the Government of China to respond to the Chinese Government Questionnaire was set as 7 November 2011, and the date for the Government of Thailand to respond to the Thailand Government Questionnaire was set as 8 November 2011.

Following formal requests by the Government of China and the Government of Thailand, Customs and Border Protection has granted:

- an extension to the Government of China to submit its response by
   5 December 2011; and
- an extension to the Government of Thailand to submit its response by
   6 December 2011.
