INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF POWER TRANSFORMERS FROM CHINA, INDONESIA, KOREA, TAIWAN, THAILAND AND VIETNAM

I refer to your letter of 7 October 2014. The responses below are numbered in accordance with the requests set out in your letter.

- 1(a) Attachment A to my letter of 2 October 2014, which is the revised non-confidential version of the submission from Wilson Transformer Company Pty Ltd (WTC) dated 10 June 2014, refers to a table containing information about particular contracts. The Commission is satisfied that the revised non-confidential version provides a reasonable understanding of the substance of the information provided in the submission, including the information contained in the table.
- 1(b) The wording in this paragraph has not been changed. The only change is in the bracketed summary from [Deleted comments on particular state contracts] to [Deleted reference to particular contracts].
- 2(a) The majority of the meeting concerned issues not related to the current investigation. To the extent the discussions covered the current investigation and WTC provided oral information that has not subsequently been put in writing, that information has not been taken into account for this investigation.
