

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2014/116

Power transformers

Exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Indonesia, the Republic of Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam

Extension of time to the due date for the final report

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 29 July 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of power transformers exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Indonesia, the Republic of Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam.

The statement of essential facts (SEF), which sets out the facts on which I, Dale Seymour, Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission propose to base my recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry (Parliamentary Secretary), was published on 18 September 2014. The due date for giving my final report to the Parliamentary Secretary was 2 November 2014. After reviewing submissions in response to the SEF, I requested an extension of 30 days to the deadline for giving the final report to the Parliamentary Secretary.

I consider that the additional time would allow the Commission to finalise its analysis in relation to the alternative approach to the assessment of dumping margins and ensure the final report provides a comprehensive account of the investigation in all aspects.

The Parliamentary Secretary has, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the due date for the final report. The final report will now be submitted to the Parliamentary Secretary no later than **2 December 2014**.
