



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/69

Iron and steel grinding mill liners

Exported from Canada

Expiration of Anti-Dumping Measures

Anti-dumping measures on iron and steel grinding mill liners exported from Canada were initially imposed by public notice on 17 September 2003 by the Minister responsible for Australian Customs and Border Protection Service following consideration of *Trade Measures Report to the Minister No.70 (REP 70)*.

On 4 October 2012, the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service published a notice in *The Australian* newspaper, in accordance with section 269ZHB of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), inviting certain persons to apply to the Anti-Dumping Commissioner for the continuation of anti-dumping measures by 3 December 2012.

As no application was received by the Commission, the anti-dumping measures applying to iron and steel grinding mill liners exported from Canada will expire on 17 September 2013. Therefore on and from 18 September 2013 anti-dumping measures will no longer apply.
