ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/90

Linear Low Density Polyethylene

Exported from Thailand

Expiration of Anti-Dumping Measures

Anti-dumping measures on linear low density polyethylene exported from Thailand were initially imposed by public notice on 3 December 2003 by the Minister responsible for Australian Customs and Border Protection Service following consideration of *Trade Measures Report to the Minister No.67 (REP 67).*

On 18 January 2013, the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service published a notice in *The Australian* newspaper, in accordance with section 269ZHB of the *Customs Act 190*, inviting certain persons to apply to the Chief Executive Officer of Customs and Border Protection for the continuation of anti-dumping measures by 19 March 2013.

As no application was received, the anti-dumping measures applying to linear low density polyethylene exported from Thailand will expire on 3 December 2013. Therefore on and from 4 December 2013 anti-dumping measures will no longer apply.
