

## **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/91**

## Geosynthetic clay liners

## **Exported from Germany**

## **Expiry of Anti-Dumping Measures**

The Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission), in accordance with subsection 269ZHB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), advises that the anti-dumping measures on geosynthetic clay liners ("the goods") exported from Germany are due to expire on 15 October 2014.

The anti-dumping measures were initially imposed by public notice on 15 October 2009 by the Minister responsible for Australian Customs and Border Protection Service following consideration of *Trade Measures Report No. 145* (REP 145).

Those persons as specified at paragraph 269ZHB(1)(b) of the Act are invited to apply to the Commission for the continuation of the anti-dumping measures. The application must be in writing, be in an approved form, contain such information that the form requires and be signed in the manner indicated in the form.

A notice advising the expiry of these anti-dumping measures was published in *The Australian* newspaper on 15 November 2013. Applications must be lodged by 14 January 2014. *[60 days from the publication of this notice in The Australian]* 

The application must provide evidence addressing whether there appear to be reasonable grounds for asserting that the expiration of the anti-dumping measures to which the application relates might lead, or might be likely to lead, to a continuation of, or a recurrence of, the material injury that the measures are intended to prevent.

If an application is received that complies with the prescribed requirements and the Anti-Dumping Commissioner decides not to reject that application, the Commission will undertake an inquiry and report to the Minister for Industry within 155 days (or by such later date as the Minister may allow in accordance with section 269ZHI of the Act). The Commission will publish a notice advising the commencement of such an inquiry.

If no application is received by the Commission within the period specified above, the antidumping measures applying to geosynthetic clay liners exported from Germany will expire on 15 October 2014. Therefore on and from 16 October 2014 anti-dumping measures would no longer apply.
