



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/97

Tubeless Steel Demountable Rims

Exported from the People's Republic of China

Expiration of Anti-Dumping Measures

Anti-dumping measures on tubeless steel demountable rims exported from the People's Republic of China were initially imposed by public notice on 31 December 2008 by the Minister responsible for the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service following consideration of Trade Measures Report No. 142. The measures include a price undertaking by Changchun FAWAY Automobile Components Co Ltd, formerly known as Changchun FAW Sihuan Automobile Co Ltd Wheel Branch Company, accepted by the Minister and entered into on 31 December 2008.

On 28 February 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commission) published a notice in *The Australian* newspaper, in accordance with section 269ZHB of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), inviting certain persons to apply to the Anti-Dumping Commissioner for the continuation of anti-dumping measures by 27 April 2013.

As no application was received by the Commission, the anti-dumping measures applying to tubeless steel demountable rims exported from the People's Republic of China will expire on 31 December 2013. Therefore on and from 1 January 2014 anti-dumping measures would no longer apply.
