



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2014/107

Geosynthetic clay liners

Exported from the Federal Republic of Germany

Expiry of Anti-Dumping Measures

Anti-dumping measures on geosynthetic clay liners (GCLs) exported from the Federal Republic of Germany (Germany) were initially imposed by public notice on 15 October 2009 by the then Minister responsible for the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service following consideration of *Trade Measures Report No. 145*.

On 15 November 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice in *The Australian* newspaper, in accordance with section 269ZHB of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), inviting certain persons to apply to the Commission for the continuation of anti-dumping measures by 14 January 2014.

As no application was received, the anti-dumping measures applying to GCLs exported from Germany will expire on 15 October 2014. Therefore on and from 16 October 2014 anti-dumping measures will no longer apply.
