Biodiesel

Exported from the United States of America

Expiry of Anti-Dumping Measures

Anti-dumping measures on biodiesel exported from the United States of America (USA) were initially imposed by public notice on 18 April 2011 by the Minister for Home Affairs following consideration of *Trade Measures Report No. 163*.

On 13 July 2015, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice in *The Australian* newspaper, in accordance with section 269ZHB of the *Customs Act 1901*, inviting certain persons to apply to the Commission for the continuation of anti-dumping measures by 11 September 2015.

As no application was received, the anti-dumping measures applying to biodiesel exported from the USA will expire on 18 April 2016.
