ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2018/51

Approved forms for applications

I, Dale Seymour, Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, have approved new forms to be used in an application for a duty assessment. I have also approved a revised form for making an application for a review of measures.

As authorised under subsection 269SMS(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I have approved Form ADC2 for the purposes of submitting an application for a duty assessment under subsection 269V(1) of the Act. I have also approved an accompanying spreadsheet template to assist an applicant provide information relevant to an application.

As authorised under subsection 269SMS(1) of the Act, I have approved a revised Form B602 for the purposes of submitting an application for a review of measures under subsection 269ZA(1) of the Act. This form has been revised following recent legislative changes which were outlined in ADN 2018/03. The revised Form B602 (published March 2018) will be the only form approved for an application for a review of measures from 21 March 2018. The *Instructions and Guidelines for Applicants on the Application for Review / Revocation Measures* have also been updated.
