## ▲ Anti-dumping

On 16 April 2019, the Ministry of Economy of Mexico initiated an antidumping investigation on imports of wind towers from China. The products subject to investigation are classified under the following HS code subheading: 8502.31.01. This investigation follows the application lodged on 3 December 2018 by Arcosa Industries de México, S. de R.L. de C.V. and Speco Wind Power, S.A. de C.V.

On 27 December 2019, the Mexican authorities imposed a provisional duty on imports of the subject good from China. The rate of duty is between 41.22% or 143.06% depending on the company. The antidumping investigation remains in progress. The resolution entered into force on 28 December 2019.

On 5 October 2020, the Mexican authorities imposed a definitive duty on imports of wind towers from China. The rate of duty is 21%. The duty entered into force on 6 October 2020.

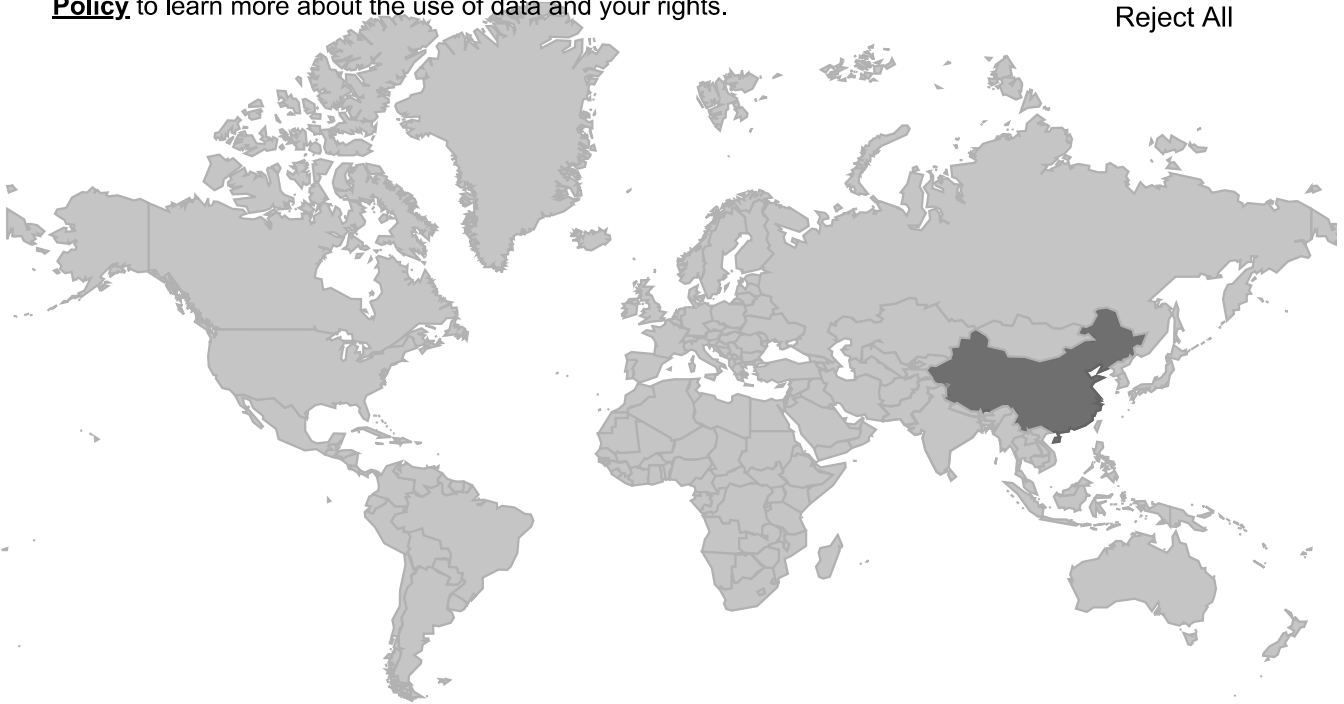
