Goods Description & Tariff Classification

The goods the subject of the anti-dumping measures are:

Flat, electric cables, comprising two copper conductor cores and an 'earth' (copper) core with a nominal conductor cross sectional area of between, and including, 2.5 mm<sup>2</sup> and 3 mm<sup>2</sup>, insulated and sheathed with polyvinyl chloride (PVC) materials, and suitable for connection to mains electricity power installations at voltages exceeding 80 volts (V) but not exceeding 1,000 V, and complying with Australian/New Zealand Standard (AS/NZS) AS/NZS 5000.2 (the Australian Standard), and whether or not fitted with connectors.

The goods are classified within tariff sub-heading 8544.49.20 (statistical code 41).

Countries/companies the subject of the measures

The current anti-dumping measures, in the form of the below referenced Dumping Duty Notice, apply to the above-noted goods exported to Australia from China.

The Australian industry seeks continuation of the measures as they apply to all exporters of the goods exported to Australia from China.

Period of Review

The applicant for this continuation nominates a review period of twelve months ending 31 March 2023.

Date of publication of the measures

The relevant *Dumping Duty Notice* is ADN No. 2019/47, published 8 May 2019.
