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Explanation of "Customs Advanced Certification Enterprise Standards"

1. Classification of certification standards

The "Customs Advanced Certification Enterprise Standards" include general standards and individual standards formulated for different enterprise types and business scopes .

2. About the certification results

The certification result options are divided into "standards met", "basically met standards", "not met standards" and "not applicable" .

Compliance: The actual situation of the enterprise meets this standard. If there are sub-standards in this standard (indicated by (1), (2), (3), etc., the same below), each sub-standard should also be met.

Basically meet the standards : The actual situation of the enterprise basically meets the standards. If there are sub-standards in this standard, each sub-standard should also be met or basically met.

Not up to standard: The actual situation of the enterprise does not meet the standard. If any of the sub-standards of this

standard are not up to standard, the standard will be considered non-compliance.

Not applicable: If the actual operation of the enterprise does not involve relevant customs business , the customs will not certify this standard.

3. Conditions for passing certification

If an enterprise meets the following three conditions at the same time and is recognized by the customs, it will pass the certification:

(1) There are no substandard conditions in all certification result options ;

(2) No more than 3 general standards must be basically met ;

(3) No more than 3 individual standards should be basically met .

4. About time calculation

" Within 1 year " means 12 consecutive months.

If you apply to become a high-level certified enterprise, the calculation will be calculated backwards from the date when the customs accepts the enterprise's application.

For re-examination of advanced certification enterprises , the calculation will be calculated backwards from the date when the latest customs administrative penalty decision is made; among them, the administrative penalty decision 12 months ago will be counted back from the date when the customs last accepted the

enterprise's application and will not be included in the calculation.
