Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan

File note to clarify the exemption goods for this inquiry

The Anti-Dumping Commission has identified that the description of the exemption goods in Anti-Dumping Notice No 2024/005 (initiation notice),¹ is different to the description of the exemption goods in MGN CIVIL Pty Ltd's application (the application).²

The goods the subject of this inquiry should be as per the application. This file note should be read with the initiation notice.

Exemption goods as per the application (and exemption goods for this inquiry):

The goods the subject of the exemption inquiry (the 'exemption goods') are described as follows:

350 grade 60mm x 120mm x 10mm thick steel rectangular tube, length of 11.9m.

Submissions

Interested parties were invited to make written submissions to the inquiry in the initiation notice. As a result of this file note, I have extended the period for submissions.

Submissions should be made no later than **8 April 2024**, and can be emailed to investigations1@adcommission.gov.au.
