



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE No. 2024/025

Continuation Inquiry No. 629 in relation to Ammonium Nitrate

**Exported from Sweden, the Kingdom of Thailand and the
People's Republic of China**

Extension of time granted to issue the Final Report

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

The Acting Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has extended the due date to publish the final report and recommendation to the Minister about the above case.¹

The Commissioner is not inviting further submissions by granting this extension.

New milestone dates

Final Report – A recommendation to the Minister will be made in a final report which is now due on, or before, **23 April 2024**.

A statement of essential facts was published on 20 February 2024. The previous due date for the final report was 19 April 2024.
