



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE No. 2024/032

Continuation Inquiry No. 632 in relation to Ore Carriage Railway Wheels

**Exported from the French Republic and the People's Republic
of China**

Extension of time granted to issue the Final Report

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

The Acting¹ Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has extended the due date to provide the final report and recommendation to the Minister about the above case.²

The Commissioner is not inviting further submissions by granting this extension.

New milestone dates

Final Report – A recommendation to the Minister will be made in a final report which is now due on, or before, **12 June 2024**.

A statement of essential facts was published on 28 March 2024. The previous due date for the final report was 6 June 2024.

Basis for extension

I, Mayuran Jeyarajah, am the Acting Deputy Commissioner Investigations, Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission). I requested the extension of the due date to provide the final report and recommendation to the Minister.

I requested the extension because of the complexity of matters raised in submissions and for the commission to finalise analysis of the relevant data.
