Clear laminate glass

Exported from the People's Republic of China and the Kingdom of Thailand

Withdrawal of application for a dumping duty notice/countervailing duty notice - Case No 647

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB¹

On 25 June 2024, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) published Anti-Dumping Notice No 2024/037 announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping and/or subsidisation of clear laminate glass (the goods) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China) and the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand).² This notice is available on the electronic public record (EPR) for this case, on the commission's website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

On 26 August 2024, the applicant withdrew the application for dumping duty notices in respect of the goods exported to Australia from China and Thailand, and countervailing duty notice in respect of the goods exported to Australia from China in accordance with section 269TB(3) of the *Customs Act 1901*. Accordingly, I have ceased the investigation concerning the application and no findings will be made on the allegations of dumping, subsidisation, material injury and causal link.
