### Silicon Metal

### Exported to Australia from The People's Republic of China

#### File Note – Exporter Questionnaire Responses

On 6 July 2024, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) notified exporters of silicon metal exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China that exporter questionnaire responses in relation to this continuation inquiry were due by no later than 8 August 2024.

The commission did not receive any responses to the exporter questionnaires by the due date of 8 August 2024.

Exporters that do not provide a response to the exporter questionnaire within the legislated period (by 8 August 2024) are deemed to be uncooperative.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Section 8 of the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-Cooperation) Direction 2015* states that the Commissioner must determine an exporter to be an uncooperative exporter if that exporter fails, within the legislated period, to provide a response or fails to request a longer period to provide a response.
